### **Selection of Projects at HOSPER**

#### **Perm Embankment City Park**

Perm's most important public space will be reorganised in the first implementation project pursuant to the Perm Master Plan. The park is in a beautiful location next to the River Kama. The park will be designed in collaboration with KCAP. The design is inspired by the park's specific location, with a large difference in height between the city and the river, and by the time at which the ice breaks in the spring. The inclined area of the park between the city balcony and the boulevard at the water's edge will be made more exciting. A new entrance will be positioned at the site of the city's origins that abuts the park. All the furniture for the park (fencing, benches, lighting, etc.) has been designed specifically for the location, 2009 - to date.

#### **Design of cultural square C-Mine in Genk (Belgium) (*Multiple submissions, 1<sup>st</sup> prize*)**

Design of a square in the midst of cultural functions in a former mine site in Genk. Commissioned by the town of Genk. Fittings designed in cooperation with Carmela Bogman, 2006-present.

#### **Rotterdamse Stijl (Rotterdam Style) Manual, elaboration of urban district structure**

Commissioned by the municipality of Rotterdam, the urban district structure is described and linked with guidelines, 2008 - present.

#### **Burgemeester Jamessingel Gouda - sub-project in the development of the light railway zone**

Commissioned by the municipality of Gouda a provisional design has been created for the redevelopment of this profile in which the RijnGouwelijjn (Rhine Gouwe Line) must be integrated. In cooperation with the Arjan Karssen bureau, 2006-present.

#### **Design of quayside element and redevelopment of Leidse Vaart Haarlem**

One of the most important lines in the town once again gains in importance by redeveloping its profile. Especially the design of the quayside element ensures that the public spaces have character. In cooperation with the Arjan Karssen bureau, and Jacqueline Moors and Ramon Jansen (concept phase), design 1995-2000 (2000 1<sup>st</sup> phase executed), 2005-2007 (2007 2<sup>nd</sup> phase executed).

### **Layout plan for Leeuwarden Zaailand**

Commissioned by the municipality of Leeuwarden, a design was developed for the layout of the Zaailand, the largest square in Leeuwarden, 2007- present.

### **Structural vision IJmuiden aan Zee**

Urban planning design and organisation of public spaces for IJmuiden aan Zee, in which questions such as the new norms for coastal safety, required coastal lighting, expansion of parking facilities and new stimuli for tourism have been integrated in an inventive manner. The plan provides for 290 new residences and 110 vacation apartments, new catering and retail establishments and provisions for bad weather. Commissioned by the municipality of Velsen, 2005-2006.

### **Design for the redevelopment of public spaces in the centre of Zuidhorn**

Design sketch and definitive design (first and second phase) for the public spaces in the centre of Zuidhorn in an open planning process with the municipality, residents and interested parties. Commissioned by the municipality of Zuidhorn, 2005 - present, in execution.
