Afsluitdijk (Barrier Dike)

Together with DHV and Wageningen IMARES created an integrated vision for the Barrier Dike. By installing tidal marshes that grow in accordance with the rise in the sea level, safety is increased and opportunities for ecological and recreational use are generated. The submission 'WaddenWerken' (MarshWorks) has been selected for further elaboration as one of the four most appealing visions. Commissioned by Rijkswaterstaat, 2008.

Design for the redevelopment of public spaces in the centre of Zuidhorn

Design sketch and definitive design (first and second phase) for the public spaces in the centre of Zuidhorn in an open planning process with the municipality, residents and interested parties. Commissioned by the municipality of Zuidhorn, 2005 - present, in execution.

Vision for the Die Hooghe Hoenderberg Care Hotel, Groesbeek

Landscape analysis and vision for the positioning and form of a Care Hotel situated on the moraine near Groesbeek. In collaboration with AAArchitects. Commissioned by the healthcare advisory bureau Triatact, 2006.

Structural vision Westerbork

Drawing up a structural vision with image quality plan for the western edge of the town of Alkmaar. In the structural vision the landscape qualities of the area are protected, the quality of the less spatially appealing portions is enhanced and a framework for future developments is provided. Master plan Meerstad Groningen (*included in the Urban Planning and Landscape Architecture Yearbook 2001 - 2003*)

Commissioned by the municipality of Groningen and Slochteren, province of Groningen, the water regulating authority, Ministry of LNV (Agriculture, Nature Management and Fisheries) and the DLG (Rural Department) the Meerstad master plan is being developed in an open planning process. The submission includes 10,000 residences, 135 hectares of commercial area, a lake of 600 hectares, 450 hectares of green space and a 350-hectare ecological main structure. In collaboration with KCAP, 2001 - 2005, in execution.

Urban planning development vision for the Huizen Vista area

Study into the possibilities of building up the Vista area in Huizen, including recommendations on the location, typology and image of the construction in relation to surrounding park areas and existing buildings in the vicinity. An open planning process with residents of adjacent neighbourhoods. Commissioned by the municipality of Huizen, 2004-2005.

Study of an integrated residential landscape at the Bypass at Kampen

Design study into possibilities for an integrated landscape at the bypass in Kampen, in which planned water storage, nature and recreation are combined with residential accommodation. Commissioned by Volker Wessels Vastgoed, 2006-2007.
