### Selection of Projects at HOSPER

#### **Watervrijstaat Gaasperdam**

View of freedom and spatial planning; strategy for the future of Gaasperdam, within the context of the Architecture Biennale Rotterdam. The work was completed with a 4 x 5 m scale model made from Lego. Commissioned by DRO Amsterdam, 2009.

#### **Perm Strategic Master Plan, Perm, Russia**

Commissioned by city management of the Russian city of Perm, the structural plan for the whole city is being drawn up. This agglomeration of 1 million inhabitants, situated on the river Kama close to the Russian Urals, is being renovated in all aspects. The Bureau Alle Hosper is designing the landscape and public space components of the plan in conjunction with the overall urban plan drawn up by KCAP, 2008 - 2009.

#### **Afsluitdijk (Barrier Dike)**

Together with DHV and Wageningen IMARES created an integrated vision for the Barrier Dike. By installing tidal marshes that grow in accordance with the rise in the sea level, safety is increased and opportunities for ecological and recreational use are generated. The submission 'WaddenWerken' (MarshWorks) has been selected for further elaboration as one of the four most appealing visions. Commissioned by Rijkswaterstaat, 2008.

#### **Spatial plan for flying base Soesterberg**

Drawing up a master plan for the development of an area - centrally situated on the back of a hill - that had previously been used as a flying base. Commissioned by the province of Utrecht and the municipalities of Soest and Zeist, 2007-present.

### **Urban planning design residential complex Wilhelminalaan Utrecht**

Urban planning design, volume and programme study for a residential complex with commercial premises on the ground floor level at the intersection of Wilhelminalaan and Europalaan in Utrecht. Commissioned by Looye Vastgoed and Van Wijnen Projectontwikkeling, 2007.

### **Study cultural plan IJdijken**
