Master plan Almelo Waterrijk

Commissioned by the municipality of Almelo, a design for the new city district on the North side of Almelo with a surface area of c. 500 hectares and 4,300 residences was created. The plan is characterised by water and a fully integrated sustainable approach. In conjunction with M3H architects and the municipality of Almelo, 2008 - 2009.

Perm Strategic Master Plan, Perm, Russia

Commissioned by city management of the Russian city of Perm, the structural plan for the whole city is being drawn up. This agglomeration of 1 million inhabitants, situated on the river Kama close to the Russian Urals, is being renovated in all aspects. The Bureau Alle Hosper is designing the landscape and public space components of the plan in conjunction with the overall urban plan drawn up by KCAP, 2008 - 2009.

Urban planning design and design for public spaces Stompetoren-Oost (*multiple contract, 1st prize*)

Commissioned by a housing corporation and a developer, a urban leisure plan was drawn up in collaboration with HM architects and the public spaces elaborated for a small village expansion (140 residences) for the core Stompetoren in Schermer, 1999-2002.

Green structural vision Haarlem

In 2003, the town of Haarlem developed a structural vision. Within this structural vision the position of green components was elaborated in greater detail into a green structure. The main design was based on the structure as conceived in the nineties. The structural vision also extensively explores the level of the neighbourhood. The instrument of the 'norm' is used in order to maintain, reinforce and possibly redistribute green elements. A norm is determined for each neighbourhood typology in which green aspects are sufficiently represented and function well. In redevelopment submissions the projects must fulfil the norm applicable to the neighbourhood; a precondition is that the nominal amount of green space may never be reduced, 2007-2009.

Design of the interior garden of the Christoffelhof te Schagen

The architecture posed a dilemma with regard to the relationship between public and private areas. By utilising unique planting and due to the manner in which space is used, this dilemma has been resolved without having to install railings, screening hedges or fences, 2002.

Urban development plan Hasselt om de Weede

Master plan and partial elaborations for Hasselt om de Weede: A unique residential landscape based on the major landscape qualities in the plan area and the immediate surroundings of natural areas such as Olde Maten, Wieden and Weerribben. 1150 residences and plan area of 100 hectares, 2006 - present.

Area elaboration Broekhorn, Heerhugowaard

Commissioned by the province of North Holland, the municipality of Heerhugowaard and Rabo Bouwfonds an integrated plan was drawn up for the reconstruction of the N242 and the development of the Broekhorn into a mixed urban area with space for living, working, nature and recreation, 2007 - present.

Bruggen Slaan, vision for the Sprong Purmerend canal

Multiple submissions for the master plan of two bridges over the North Holland Canal in order to connect the town centre with the new Kop van West. In collaboration with M3H architects, commissioned by the municipality of Purmerend, 2007.
