Spatial plan for flying base Soesterberg

Drawing up a master plan for the development of an area - centrally situated on the back of a hill - that had previously been used as a flying base. Commissioned by the province of Utrecht and the municipalities of Soest and Zeist, 2007-present.

Master Plan Zuidhoek & Meijepark, Nieuwkoop

Bureau Alle Hosper was commissioned by the Municipality of Nieuwkoop to draw up an urban plan for a residential district and adjacent recreational area. The site, a former landfill site, is located at the Zuideinderplas in Nieuwkoop. In collaboration with Planmaat, 2009 - to date.
