### **Selection of Projects at HOSPER**

#### **Perm Strategic Master Plan, Perm, Russia**

Commissioned by city management of the Russian city of Perm, the structural plan for the whole city is being drawn up. This agglomeration of 1 million inhabitants, situated on the river Kama close to the Russian Urals, is being renovated in all aspects. The Bureau Alle Hosper is designing the landscape and public space components of the plan in conjunction with the overall urban plan drawn up by KCAP, 2008 - 2009.

#### **Perm Embankment City Park**

Perm's most important public space will be reorganised in the first implementation project pursuant to the Perm Master Plan. The park is in a beautiful location next to the River Kama. The park will be designed in collaboration with KCAP. The design is inspired by the park's specific location, with a large difference in height between the city and the river, and by the time at which the ice breaks in the spring. The inclined area of the park between the city balcony and the boulevard at the water's edge will be made more exciting. A new entrance will be positioned at the site of the city's origins that abuts the park. All the furniture for the park (fencing, benches, lighting, etc.) has been designed specifically for the location, 2009 - to date.

#### **Interior gardens Oranjegracht/Waardgracht Leiden**

Commissioned by the housing corporation, a design was created for five green, collective interior gardens, design 2005, executed 2007.

#### **Structural vision Westerbork**

Commissioned by the municipality of Midden-Drenthe, a structural vision is being worked on for the village of Westerbork, 2007 - present, in an open planning process.

#### **Vision and organisational design for Venster Bodegraven-Woerden**

Commissioned by the province of Zuid-Holland (South Holland), a vision has been drawn up for the joint authorities (municipalities, provinces, state departments and water authorities) with the title 'inspiratie voor realisatie' ('inspiration before realisation') for this icon in the Green Heart. Subsequently, an organisational plan was put together to fortify the open middle area with water, development of natural environment, agricultural administration and recreation, 2007 - 2009.

### **Landscape plan and urban plan for the commercial area Buitenvaart 2 in Hoogeveen**

Commissioned by the municipality of Hoogeveen, a commercial area was designed that on the one hand is efficiently linked to the motorway and on the other hand allows space for the village of Hollandscheveld and the surrounding open pasture, 2000 - present, in execution.

### **Master plan Meerstad Groningen (*included in the Urban Planning and Landscape Architecture Yearbook 2001 - 2003*)**

Commissioned by the municipality of Groningen and Slochteren, province of Groningen, the water regulating authority, Ministry of LNV (Agriculture, Nature Management and Fisheries) and the DLG (Rural Department) the Meerstad master plan is being developed in an open planning process. The submission includes 10,000 residences, 135 hectares of commercial area, a lake of 600 hectares, 450 hectares of green space and a 350-hectare ecological main structure. In collaboration with KCAP, 2001 - 2005, in execution.

### **Ecological city park Grolsche Weide Groenlo (*nomination European Planning Award, 2004*)**

Commissioned by the municipality of Groenlo, a design sketch was created for the expansive green intermediate area between two former factory complexes. In the design open spaces were laid out to guide the eye to the surrounding area. In collaboration with Willem Overmars Ecologisch Advies, 2003-2004.
