Antwerp Park Groot Schijn (Belgium) (*invited competition, 1st prize*)

Design for a new landscaped park with sports, recreation, nature, allotments, youth movements, caravan site, cemetery and a play forest. In the winning design 'joints and rooms' a cohesive park tissue is created. In conjunction with met BUUR, BULK and Atelier Ruimtelijk Advies. Commissioned by AG Stadsplanning Antwerp, 2013-present.

Antwerp Kievit District (Belgium) (*invited competition, 1st prize*)

The Belgian-Dutch combination BUUR-HOSPER-Atelier Ruimtelijk Advies has won the design selection for the redevelopment of the public space Kievit phase II in Antwerp. For the refurbishment of the outdoor space a green plan was drawn up with iconic planting. Commissioned by AG Stadsplanning Antwerpen, 2012-present.

Heemstede Havendreef
