Rotterdam Rijks Inspectie Terminal

Along with the new terminal the project includes the construction of a practical training centre and a dog training course. In collaboration with Corovum, 2014-present.

Utrecht PPS De Knoop

Transformation of the former Knoopkazerne, located in the station area of Utrecht, into a new Governmental office with semi-public space. Three consortia have been selected to develop a vision and plan in consultation with the Government Buildings Agency. Commissioned by Züblin Netherlands / Strabag Belgium, in collaboration with UNStudio, Storimans Wijffels Architecten, Veldhoen + Company, Affaire d'Architecture, Nelissen, Van Rossum, Cees van Vliet Management bv and Sodexo. Design 2014.

Callantsoog water storage area Polder 't Hoekje

Commissioned by the Dutch Water Board Hollands Noorderkwartier a landscape plan has been made for water storage in Polder 't Hoekje near Callantsoog. In the design water storage is combined with a meadow, breeding and spawning grounds for fish and a recreational trail. In collaboration with the DG Groep. Design 2012-2013, implementation 2013-2014.

Landscape Park Rhoon Noordrand

Design for a landscaped park between Rhoon and Barendrecht. In an urban environment dominated by overhead and underground infrastructure, a landscaped park has been realized with a strong mark. Commissioned by OMMIJ (Ontwikkelings Maatschappij Midden IJsselmonde: a partnership between the municipalities of Albrandswaard and Barendrecht). In collaboration with the DG Groep. Design 2011-2013, implementation 2012-2015.

Structure plan Huizen

The preparation of a structure plan for the municipality of Huizen. Commissioned by the municipality of Huizen, 2009-2011. The structure plan has been established.

Design Gardens Care Home Vivaldi Zoetermeer

Drawing up a design for the exterior space (gardens, forecourt and car park) of the Vivaldi Nursing Home in Zoetermeer, as an elaboration of the defined vision for the entire care cluster. Commissioned by Vierstroomzorging. Design 2009-2011, implementation 2010-'11.

Afsluitdijk 'WaddenWerken' (*selected for elaboration in 2008, voted public favourite in 2010*)

Together with DHV and Wageningen IMARES, a comprehensive vision for the Afsluitdijk - Barrier Dike - has been created. The construction of salt marshes that grow with rising sea levels, will increase safety and create opportunities for ecology and recreational use. The exhibit "WaddenWerken" - The Wadden Works - is selected as one of the four most compelling visions for further elaboration and has gained the audience preference. Commissioned by Rijkswaterstaat, 2008-2010.

Masterplan Meerstad Groningen (*invited competition, 1st prize*) (*included in the Yearbook Landscape Architecture and Urban Design 2001 - 2003*)

Commissioned by the Municipality of Groningen and Slochteren, Groningen Province, the Water Board, Ministry of Agriculture and the DLG and in an open planning process the Meerstad Masterplan came into being. The assignment includes 10,000 homes, 135 hectare business park, a lake of 600 hectares, 450 hectares of greenery and 350 hectares of ecological network. In collaboration with KCAP. Design 2001-2005, implementation 2009-present.
