Selection of Projects at HOSPER

Diksmuide Grote Markt (Belgium)

Masterplan for the public space in the centre of Diksmuide and redesign of the Grote Markt - market square - . In cooperation with Grontmij Belgium, commissioned by the City of Diksmuide. Design 2015-present.

Redevelopment IJsselkade and Groenmarkt Zutphen

The main purpose of the plan is to redesign the IJssel quay as an attractive boulevard and entrance to the historic town of Zutphen and to refurbish the Groenmarkt. In collaboration with the DG groep. Commissioned by the municipality of Zutphen. Design 2012-present.

Antwerp Kievit District (Belgium) (*invited competition, 1st prize*)

The Belgian-Dutch combination BUUR-HOSPER-Atelier Ruimtelijk Advies has won the design selection for the redevelopment of the public space Kievit phase II in Antwerp. For the refurbishment of the outdoor space a green plan was drawn up with iconic planting. Commissioned by AG Stadsplanning Antwerpen, 2012-present.

Canopy Amstelveen Zonnehuis Care Home

Commissioned by Zonnehuisgroep Amstelland a plan was made for the outer areas of the Zonnehuis nursing home. Above an iconic plaza floor and green oases with lush plantings a spectacular canopy was designed. In association with Architectuurcentrale Thijs Asselbergs and Octatube. Design 2011-2012, implementation 2012.

Design for the Wilhelmina Square in Leeuwarden (*Falco Award Best Public Space 2013*)

Commissioned by the municipality of Leeuwarden HOSPER made a design for the layout of the Wilhelmina square (formerly Zaailand) and its surroundings. Using contemporary means residents and users have been actively involved in the design of Leeuwarden's largest square. In cooperation with SmitsRinsma, Het LUXlab, Rots Maatwerk, IPV Delft, Falco BV and Bert Bandringa (mun. Leeuwarden). Design 2007-2011, implemented 2012-2014.

Manual for the public space of Rotterdam ("Rotterdamse Stijl"), main and district structure
Commissioned by the municipality of Rotterdam, the district structure is described and related guidelines for the design of public space were drawn up. In cooperation with the municipality of Rotterdam (dS + V, OBR, GW and PMBR), 2008-2010.

Design public space for the Droste Site in Haarlem (*nomination Lieven de Keypenning 2011, Nomination Arie Keppler Award 2011*)

Commissioned by DMV Vastgoed, a design was drawn up for the layout of public spaces for the new central residential location on the Droste site, the former chocolate factory along the Spaarne river. Design 2002-2009, implementation 2007-2009.

Landscape and urban vision for the Hageveld estate and ornamental pond (*invited competition, 1st prize*) (*finalist Dutch Design Awards 2008, Arie Keppler Award 2009, Yearbook Landscape Architecture and Urban Design 2010, Nomination Best Private Plots 2010*)

Former seminary which has been converted to flats, a secondary school is located at the back. A large pond has been designed for the forecourt, with special light shafts and fountains, above the underground car park. In cooperation with Braaksma & Roos and KBNG (MYJ Groep Architecten (architecture) and the Stijlgroep (construction of green areas), Commissioned by Synchroon (Hopman Interheem groep). Competition 2002, design 2002-2006, implementation 2005-2008.

Water management artworks - Recreational area Heerhugowaard-South Park of Luna (*nomination 'special merit award' for European Planning Award 2010, nomination Rosa Barba-prize 2010*)

A major self-cleaning water system has been developed for the recreation area of Heerhugowaard-Zuid. Works of art were made for the system which contribute to the experience value of the area. As a result a bridge, a pumping station and viewpoint and the inlet to the 'flow labyrinth' were created. In cooperation with DRFTWD Office Associates, Nelen en Schuurmans and Tauw. Commissioned by the municipality of Heerhugowaard. Final design and supervisions 2004, implementation 2006.

Spui lighting - elaboration of de Kern Gezond' ('the Healthy Core') centre of the Hague

Commissioned by the municipality of the Hague and in conjunction with HTM, a design was drawn up for combined tram-high mast lighting columns. Different types of masts were made for this project. The light fittings on the pylons and the hanging fittings for the intersections have been especially developed for this project. In cooperation with Ramon Jansen, Jacqueline Moors, Holland Railconsult, Philips Lightning, PMF Machinefabriek and HTM. Design 1997-2004, implementation 2005.
