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## ESTATE HAGEVELD

In 2002 a plan was made to transform the Hageveld Estate into private housing and expand the space for the school's sporting activities. The landscape intervention enhances the green character of the estate and restores the heavily damaged planting on the west-side of the estate with trees. A large pond was designed on top of a new underground car park. The entrance slope slits through the water and glass panels ensure daylight entree and fountains produce bubbles just above water level. The Hageveld estate is re-established as a unity, open to the public, offering the different types of users a peaceful, green, historic setting for a wide range of activities.
