## Care complex new style

Differentiated housing typologies, high-quality meeting places and a good level of facilities are fundamental in the ambition for the redevelopment of the Zuiderheide Care Home in Hilversum. Commissioned by Dudok Wonen, Moke architects created the urban design. HOSPER was asked to design the public space, including the garden on the parking deck.

The buildings offer social services for the whole neighbourhood - such as a restaurant, doctor and nursery - that stimulate a continuous and dynamic use. The residents can continue living in their neighbourhood and care facilities are provided close by, by Zuiderheide and housing services the centre Egelantier.

**Green decor**

The sloping ground level provides an opportunity for parking under a deck. The parking garage is light and naturally ventilated and has cutouts for large trees. The deck-level homes have terraces or gardens on the deck. In between are public paths and cheerful green beds inspired by the surrounding moorland.
